The field of African area studies emphasizes continental Africa and embraces all major regions of the continent. The interdisciplinary minor requires six courses: two African language courses (8 credits), two core courses (6 credits), and two elective courses (6 credits), for a total of 20 credits.

Credits from honors, topics courses, independent study, internships, and study abroad in Africa may apply toward elective requirements. Approval may be required. Bring a syllabus for advising review.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in all courses counted toward the minor. At least three courses must be at the 300 level or above, and at least three courses must be outside the student's major.
